



Public Information Meeting #4

A public information meeting will be held to review additional work being completed for Phase II of the CR 14 Reconstruction Studies. Phase I Study for the project was concluded in June 2004 with selection of an overall design concept that would reconstruct CR 14 on the existing alignment. The design concept is divided into three segments: the Rice Creek Chain of Lakes Segment (Segment 1); the Centerville Segment (Segment 2); and, the 20th Avenue to the I-35E interchange Segment (Segment 3). The design for each segment is based on anticipated daily and peak hour traffic volumes that CR 14 is expected to carry, the number of access points or intersections provided on CR 14 and the character of the adjacent land uses. Accordingly, Segment 1 will be reconstructed as a two-lane roadway with shoulders and ditches, and turn lanes added at the park entrance; Segment 2 as a three-lane roadway with curb and gutter, and a continuous left turn lane; and Segment 3 as a four-lane divided roadway with curb and gutter. Anoka County and the cities of Centerville and Lino Lakes have endorsed the design concept.

The public information meeting will be held in an open house format providing the public an opportunity to review the CR 14 design concept and additional environmental impact information including new information on right-of-way acquisition, noise, social, economic, park and wetland impacts. Representatives from the Anoka County Highway Department will be available to answer questions and receive input.

Phase II Study for the CR 14 project will continue for approximately eight months with right-of-way needs being identified in Spring/Summer 2005. There will be additional opportunities for public involvement as the layout is developed further and additional analysis is completed for community and environmental impacts.
