Dear Secretary Buttigieg:

I am writing in support of Sherburne County's application for funding though the United States Department of Transportation's Infrastructure for Rebuilding America (INFRA) Program. If awarded, the funding would be used to complete a long-planned interchange at U.S. Highway 169 and County Highway 4 in Zimmerman, Minnesota. Completing this project would address critical safety concerns, enhance access to the Twin Cities metropolitan area, and provide additional capacity to support increasing traffic volumes in the region.

U.S. Highway 169 is a vital north-south arterial route that extends from central Minnesota to the Twin Cities metropolitan area and into southern Minnesota. The highway serves an important role in supporting commuters, freight movement, and recreational travel. Currently, U.S. Highway 169 in the city of Zimmerman is an outdated four-lane divided highway with at-grade roadway and driveway intersections, traffic signals at major intersections, and limited frontage road systems. The intersection remains as one of the last signalized intersections on U.S. Highway 169 and the State of Minnesota ranks this intersection as one of the most dangerous intersections in the state.

Funding from the INFRA Program would improve a critical junction in Minnesota's transportation network by installing a hybrid diamond interchange at U.S. Highway 169 and County Road 4 in Zimmerman, Minnesota. Completing the project would also consolidate and improve 18 local roadway access and 26 private access points on U.S. Highway 169 and include a multimodal pedestrian and bicycle trail facility connection on County Highway 4. This would eliminate significant safety issues, expand capacity, enhance accessibility, and support regional freight and tourism industries that rely on this critical corridor. This project would also help rural communities accommodate planned long-term growth and link them to economic opportunities in the Twin Cities metropolitan area.

Again, I support Sherburne County's application for funding through the United States Department of Transportation's Infrastructure for Rebuilding America Program. In the last five years alone, 92 crashes, including one fatality, have occurred at this intersection with damages estimated at \$15.9 million. Our deputies typically are the first to respond to these crashes, witnessing firsthand the lifechanging events that are put into motion. The Sherburne County Sheriff's Office supports this initiative knowing we could provide a safer route, not only for motorists, but for pedestrian and bicyclists, alike.
