# Identity of driver killed in wrong-way crash on Interstate 29 released

Traill County, N.D. — A man died in a head-on crash that was caused by driving the wrong way on Interstate 29 just north of Grandin early Sunday, Nov. 12.

The North Dakota Highway Patrol received a report of a pickup traveling north in the southbound lanes of the interstate shortly after 12:30 a.m. on Sunday.

The crash, according to a preliminary report, happened about 16 minutes later a mile north of Grandin.

The driver of the Ford F-150 was identified as Siemubonue Torh, a 39 year old man from Fargo. He died in the crash.

Two people, a driver and passenger, were in the semi. It is registered in Saskatchewan, Canada.

Neither of the people in the semi were hurt. The driver was Khushpal Brar, 28, of Regina. The passenger was Jagroop Singh, 22, also of Regina.

The crash remains under investigation.
