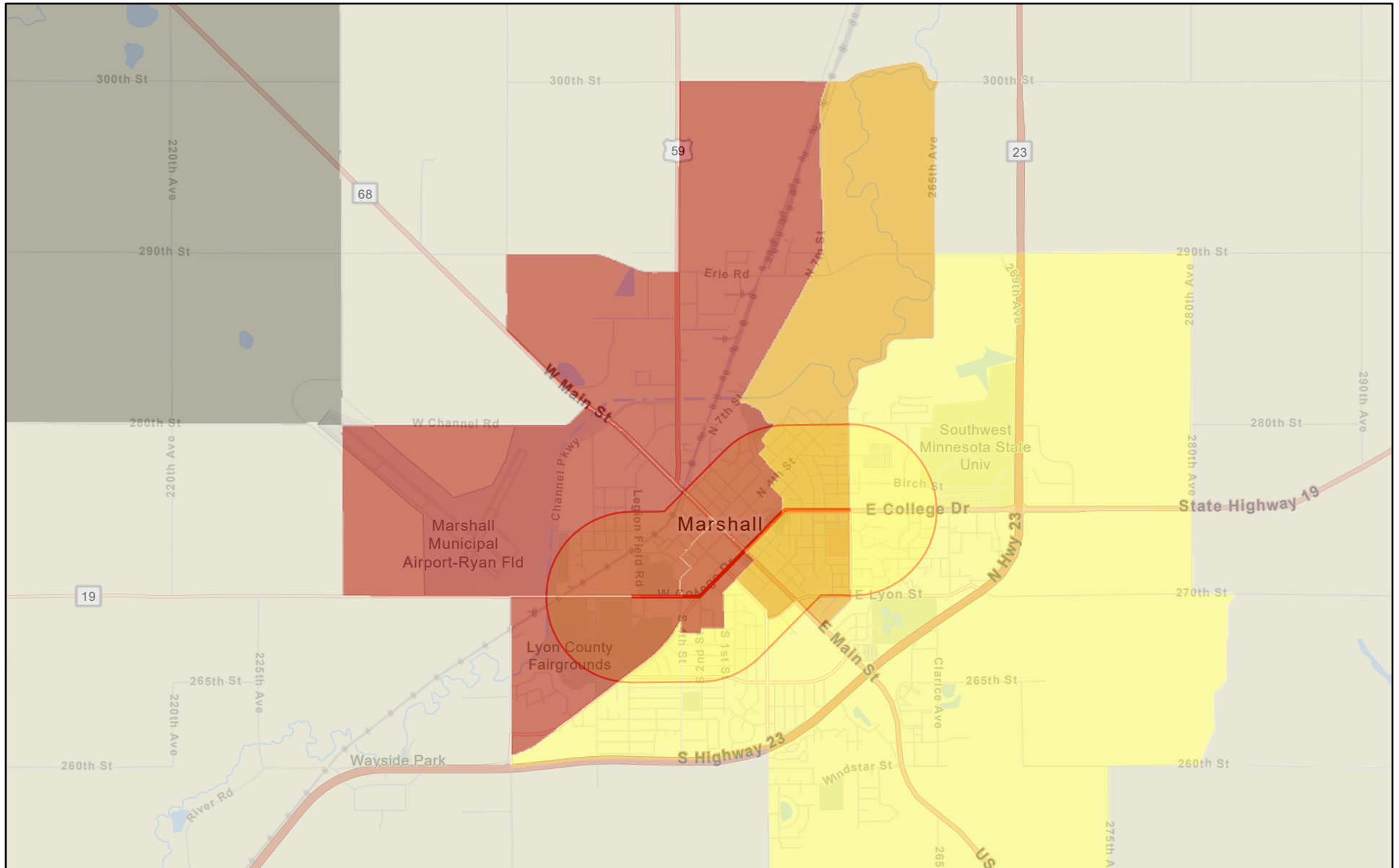
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RMP Facility Proximity

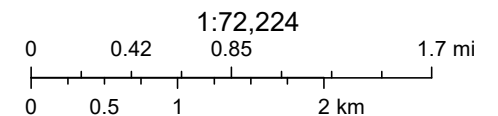

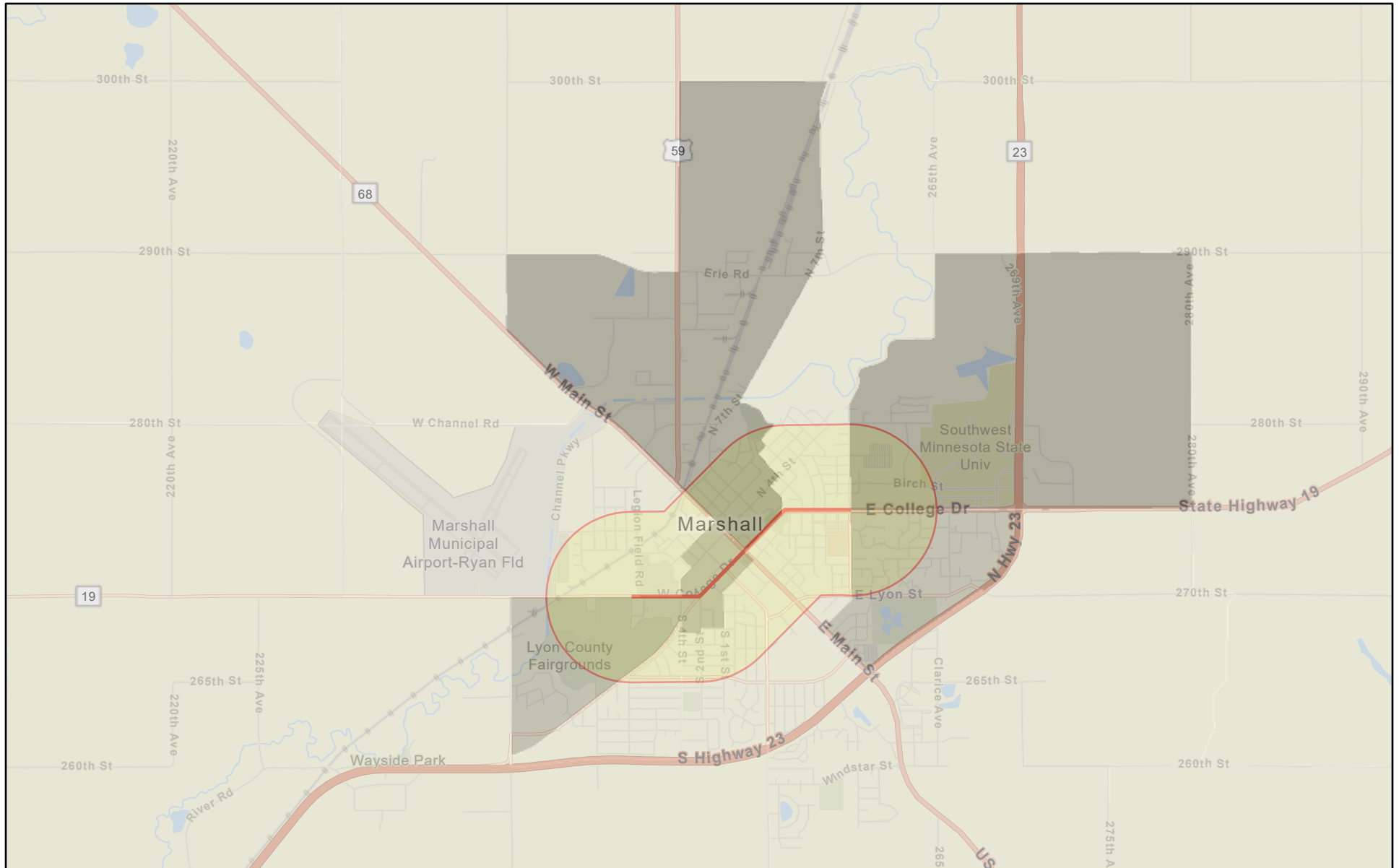

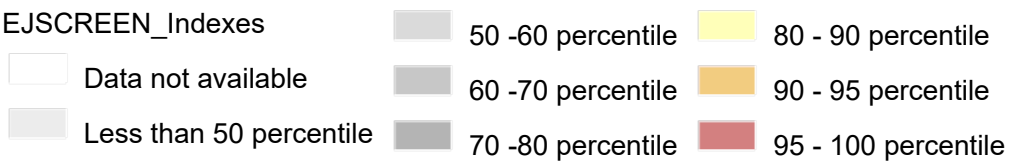

Underground Storage Tanks

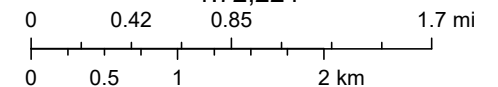

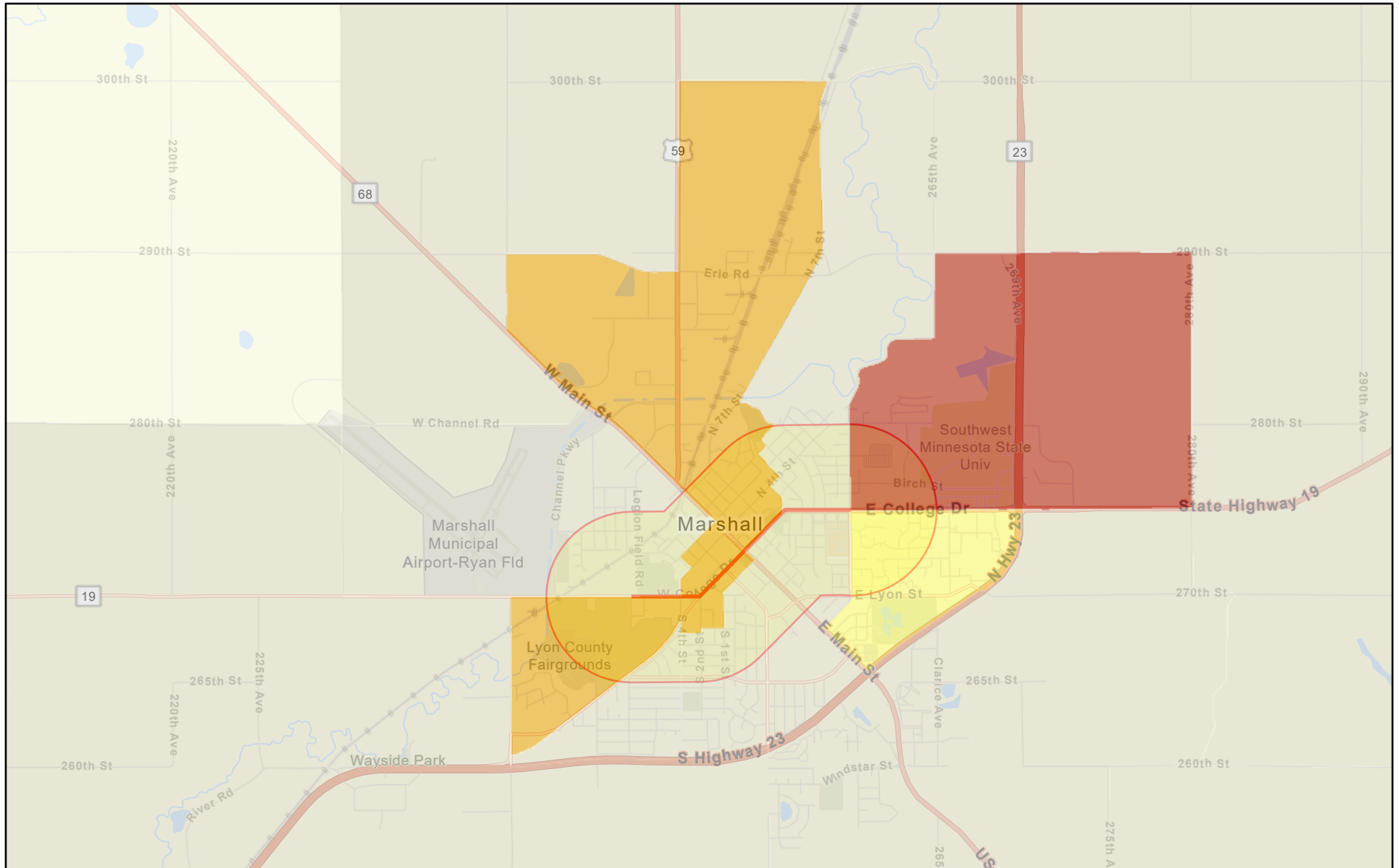


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Wastewater Discharge

100 Year Flood Plain

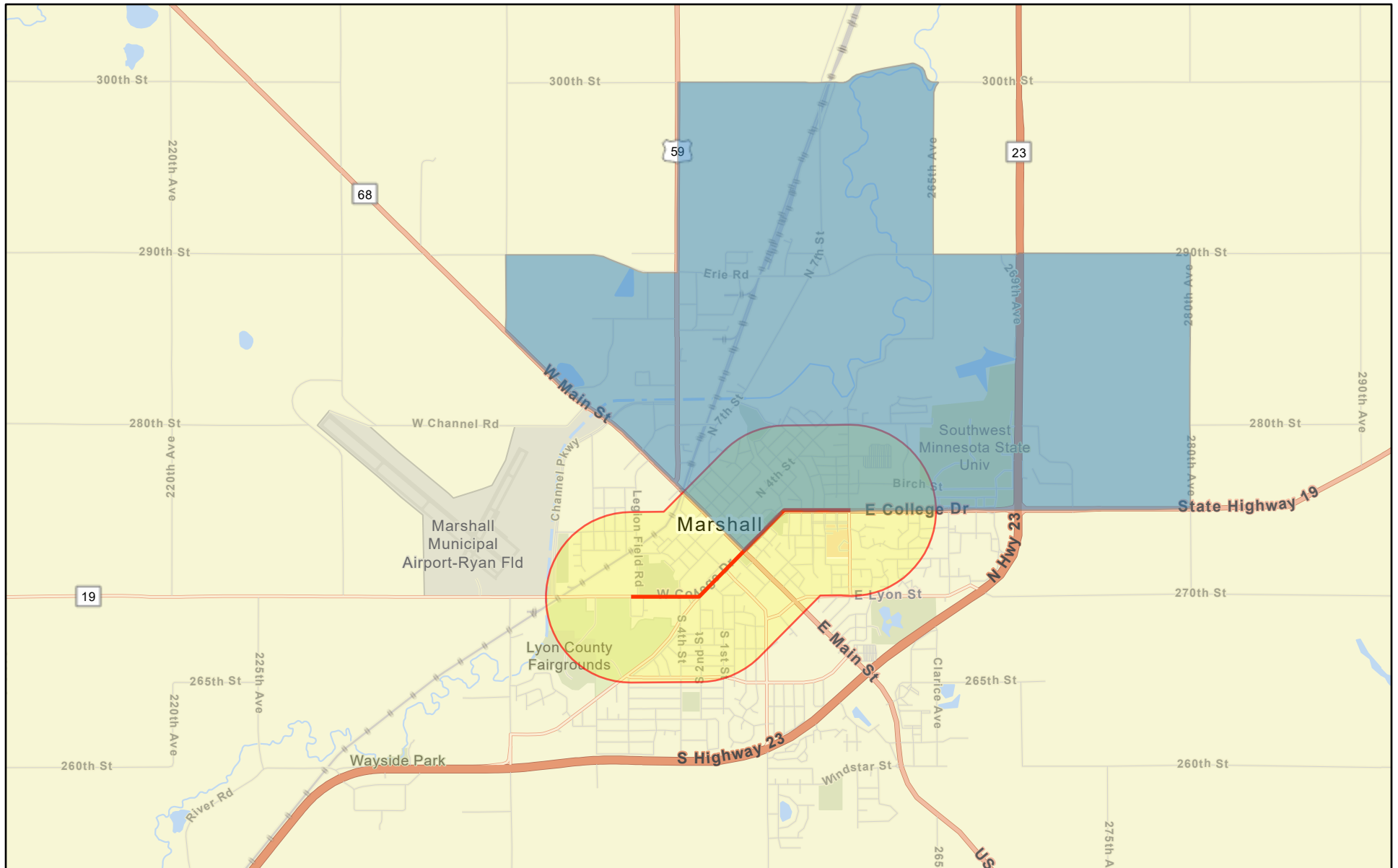
