WHEREAS, the Standing Rock Sioux Tribal Council empowered by appropriate motion, resolution or ordinance, under Article IV, Section 1[a], and 1[b], to negotiate with Federal, State and local governments and others on behalf of the Tribe, to advise and consult with the representatives of the Department of Interior on all activities of the Department which may affect the Tribe and is further empowered to advise the Secretary of Interior on all appropriations estimates of Federal projects for the benefit of the Tribe or the reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Title 23 U.S.C., Section 204[j] states "..... The Indian Tribal Government in cooperation with the Secretary of the Interior, and as may be appropriate, with the State, local government, or metropolitan planning organization, shall develop a transportation improvement program, that includes all Indian reservation road projects proposed for funding. The Projects shall be selected by the Indian Tribal Government from the Transportation Improvement Program and shall be subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary"; and
