WHEREAS,	a high priority project to address pedestrian safety was selected from the Highway Safety Plan to be submitted for a Safe Routes 4 All (SS44A) grant opportunity, and
WHEREAS,	the White Earth DOT Tribal Transportation Improvement Plan was revised to provide the necessary local match of 20% for the grant application, now
